

New Scout Uniform

1st Stotfold Cherokee Cub Pack Information Guide



Information for new and current Cub Scouts on the new uniform introduced in 2001.

The new Cub Scout Uniform consists of a dark green sweatshirt with navy blue activity trousers. All sections (Beavers, Cubs, Scouts and Explorers) now wear the same activity trousers. So the trousers do not need to be changed on the move from Cubs to Scouts.

A Cub Scout also requires a neckerchief. This has not changed from the previous uniform and is green with a yellow border.

An optional extra to the uniform is the Cub polo shirt. This is the same colour as the sweatshirt and is ideal for the summer period.

Other optional extras to the uniform include a Scout baseball cap, that shows the new Scout logo on the front. Other Scout branded items include a fleece (£25), waterproof jacket (£25) and activity shorts.

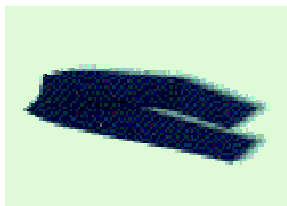


Sweatshirt

The Cub Scout sweatshirt, when worn with the Group Scarf and Woggle completes the official uniform for this section of the Movement. Made from polycotton with slightly scooped back with vents in the side seams at the hem.

Colour: dark green

30" to 34" chest: £10.00



Activity Trousers

Navy Blue, brushed polycotton cargo style trousers.

To fit ages 7/8, 9/10 and 11/12: £15.00

Activity Shorts

To fit ages 5/6, 7/8 and 9/10: £13.00



Polo Shirt

A practical yet smart alternative to the sweatshirt, this three buttoned pique Polo Shirt also has a ribbed collar and cuffs slightly scooped back plus vents in the side seams at the hem.

Colour: dark green
